

Wichita Asian Association Student Scholarship

The Wichita Asian Association (WAA) Student Scholarship is a scholarship geared towards high school students in their junior year in Wichita and the surrounding areas. The scholarship is awarded to an individual to recognize the achievements and contributions of Asian students to their community. The individual will be awarded and recognized at the Wichita Asian festival their senior year in October 2020. Additionally, the recognized individual needs to be available for occasional WAA events.

Scholarship Amount: \$500 will be awarded to a single individual.

Timeline: Submissions are due by May 4, 2020.

The applications will be reviewed and select individuals will be invited to an interview. Selected individuals and the Review Committee will be in contact for scheduling interview times.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a current Junior in High School (Homeschool students are also eligible), with an average academic GPA of 3.25 or more.
- Be at least ¼ Asian
- Reside within Wichita or within a 50-mile radius of Wichita
- Be a US citizen or provide evidence of lawful permanent residence in the US.
- Complete and submit the Application along with required supporting documents within the application deadline.
- Submit a recent photo
- Be available for an in-person interview during September 2020 (date may vary).
- Attend the Wichita Asian Festival on October 24, 2020 to receive award.
- Be available to attend occasional WAA events during senior year.
